### **Definitions**

- Community Land Trust (CLT): a democratically governed, membership-based not-for-profit organization that purchases and stewards land for a community of people in order to ensure the land remains permanently affordable and under the community's control
  - a. "Contest for the soul of the CLT" some CLTs serve mainly as a vehicle for community control, whereas others serve mainly as a tool for affordable housing.
- 2. **Tripartite Board**: board of directors that consists of 1/3 CLT residents, 1/3 community members, and 1/3 public interest representatives
